**JOHN TORY STRONGLY FAVOURED AS ONTARIO LIBERAL LEADER.
LIBERALS LED BY JOHN TORY WOULD WIN PROVINCIAL ELECTION.**

Key Findings

- **John Tory strongly favoured for Ontario Liberal leader in new poll:** Tory has the support of 4-in-10 Ontario voters as Liberal party leader (41%). No other candidate has more than one twentieth of voters in support (4%)
- **Liberals led by John Tory would win a provincial election if it were held tomorrow:** The Ontario Liberals with Tory as their leader have the support of two thirds (32%), compared to about one quarter for the NDP/Horwath (27%) or the PCs/Ford (27%).
- **John Tory's favourables exceed Doug Ford's approvals across the province:** About 4-in-10 Ontario voters have a favourable opinion of John Tory (43%), compared to just one quarter who approve of Doug Ford (24%).
- **With current leaders in place, Ford's PCs win an election held tomorrow:** With the current party leaders in place, the PCs have the support of one third of voters (35%), compared to about 3-in-10 supporting the Liberals (27%) or one quarter of the NDP (25%).

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Detailed Findings

John Tory strongly favoured for Ontario Liberal leader in new poll

TORONTO, MAY 8, 2019 - In a sampling of public opinion taken by Corbett Communications on May 2 and 3, 2019, among 1836 Ontario voters, as many as 4-in-10 (41%) would support John Tory in an Ontario Liberal leadership contest, while fewer than one twentieth (4%) would support any other likely candidate. Among Liberal voters from the last provincial election, support for the mayor of Toronto is even higher (50%).

Liberals would win an election held tomorrow with John Tory as leader

In a series of trial heats with different candidates for the Liberal leadership, Doug Ford's PCs and Andrea Horwath's NDP routinely tie in a provincial election, while the Liberals come in third. The exception to this is when the Liberal party is led by John Tory, in which case they defeat the Ford government (Liberals/Tory - 32%, PCs/Ford - 27%, NDP/Horwath - 27%, Greens/Schreiner - 12%).

John Tory's favourables exceed Doug Ford's approvals across the province

Four-in-ten of the province's voters have a favourable view of John Tory (43%) and his net score (favourable minus unfavourable) is a healthy +21. In the city of Toronto, his favourables are in majority territory (56%), and his net score is an enviable +33. No other Liberal leadership candidate has favourables in excess of one tenth. Doug Ford, on the other hand, has the approval of significantly fewer voters, or just a quarter of the province (24%), while two thirds disapprove (66%) and his net score (approve minus disapprove) is a dismal -42. Among women, the situation is even more dire - fewer than one fifth approve of the premier (16%) and as many as 7-in-10 disapprove (72%), for a net score (approve minus disapprove) of -56.

With current leaders in place, Ford's PCs win an election held tomorrow.

If a provincial election were held tomorrow, with the current leaders in place, one third would vote for the PCs (35%), about 3-in-10 would vote for the Liberals (27%) and about a quarter for the NDP (25%). About one tenth will vote Green (12%). A Ford government would be unlikely to form a majority as they are five points lower than they were in the election of June 2018.

"With the rapid decline in Doug Ford's approvals, the Liberals lacking a leader and the NDP's inability to punch through, John Tory has become the unofficial leader of the opposition, not just in Toronto, but across the province. While the Ford government might be re-elected tomorrow, without a Liberal leader in place, this is a meaningless metric.

John Tory has honed his chops at Toronto city hall, and Ontario voters now see him, not only as a viable party leader, but a promising premier. This time the leadership is his for the taking, if he wants it", said John Corbett, principal and founder of Corbett Communications.

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Methodology

This poll was conducted by Corbett Communications on May 2 and 3, among an online sample of 1836 Ontario voters 18 years of age and older who are members of Maru/Blue's Maru Voice Canada Online Panel. Panel members are recruited to reflect the population profile described in the 2016 Statistics Canada data and are paid various incentives for their participation.

As this is an opt-in sample, no margin of error is presented. For comparison purposes, a randomly selected sample of this size would have a margin of error of plus or minus 2.4%, nineteen out of twenty times asking

Where appropriate, data has been weighted to ensure the sample matches the actual population profile according to the latest Statistics Canada data.

This poll is not intended to predict the future but is a "slice of time" view of public opinion. Corbett Communications has released this poll in the public interest and has no stake in its results.
