ONTARIO SEEN TO BE ON 'WRONG TRACK' BY 6-IN-10 VOTERS

**PROVINCIAL LIBERALS TIED WITH ONTARIO
PCs IF PROVINCIAL ELECTION HELD TOMORROW**

**ANDREA HORWATH WITH TWICE THE APPROVAL OF OTHER PARTY
LEADERS, FORD HAS DISAPPROVAL OF TWO THIRDS OF VOTERS**

**CHRISTINE ELLIOTT PREFERRED TO
OTHER POTENTIAL PC LEADERS**

**JOHN TORY SEEN AS BEST CHOICE FOR PROVINCIAL LIBERAL

DETAILED FINDINGS

As many as 6-in-10 Ontarians see the province being on the 'wrong track' (60%).

TORONTO, AUGUST 16, 2019 - In an online sampling of public opinion taken by Corbett Communications among 1099 Ontario voters 18 years of age and older between August 11 and August 13, six-in-ten think the province is on the 'wrong track' (60%), compared to just one quarter who see it on the 'right track' (27%). Seeing the province on the right track is characteristic of males (34%) rather than females (22%), of those 25 to 34 and the oldest (31% each), those in rural Eastern Ontario and the GTA surrounding Toronto (31% each), PC supporters especially (65%), federal Conservatives (53%), supporters of the PPC 57%) and those who approve of Doug Ford (74%). Belief Ontario is on the wrong track is especially characteristic of Northern Ontario (72%), Hamilton-Niagara (73%), Toronto (67%), among provincial Liberals (73%), New Democrats (85%) and Greens (79%), federal Liberals 75%), New Democrats (82%) and Greens (78%). Of note, one fifth of current PC supporters (21%) and even more past PC voters (26%) believe the province is on the wrong track. Among the small minority in "Ford Nation", one fifth believe the province is wrong-tracked (17%).

Provincial Liberals and PCs are tied in voter intention if election were held tomorrow. NDP are in the mix.

Ontario voters are equally likely to say they would support the provincial Liberals (30%) as they are to say they would support the PCs (30% as well) in a provincial election were held tomorrow. The provincial NDP draws the support of just fewer (28%). About one tenth will support the provincial Green Party (11%). This represents remarkable stability since last month, when almost the same results prevailed (July 12, Liberals and PCs - 28% each, NDP - 26%). The additional support for each of these three parties appears to have come from the Greens (July 12 - 15%).

Liberals find their best support among females (33%) rather than males (27%), among the oldest (34%), in Ottawa (39%), Toronto (40%), while PC supporters are common among males (36%) rather than females (24%), among the oldest (36%), in Eastern Ontario (38%) and in the GTA surrounding Toronto (38%). The New Democrats find their support among those 35 to 44 years old (34%), 45 to 54 years (35%), in Hamilton-Niagara (45%) and in Southwest Ontario (34%), Of note, close to one fifth of those who voted NDP in June 2018 will vote Liberal in the next election (18%). Among members of "Ford Nation", 7-in-10 will vote PC (70%), but one fifth will vote Liberal (17%)

Andrea Horwath with highest approvals, almost twice other leaders

Close to one half the electorate approve of the job Andrea Horwath is doing as leader of the opposition (44%) and her net score (approve minus disapprove) is a healthy +19. This compares to last month, when her favourables were somewhat lower (40%) and her net score was a positive, but somewhat less impressive +14. Mike Schreiner of the Green Party has the approval of one quarter (25%), and his net score is a favourable +12, similar to his net score of +13 last month.. John Fraser, who is merely a placeholder at this point, has the approval of one fifth of voters (22%) and his net score is a negligible (but positive) +3 (compared to +2 last month). Doug Ford has the approval of one quarter of voters as well (24%), but with disapproval from fully two thirds of the electorate (65%), his net score is a dismal -41. This is a slight improvement from last month, when his approval was 20%, his disapproval 69% and his net score -49%). His favourability among the very small group described as "Ford Nation" is high (89%).

Christine Elliott preferred to others if Doug Ford is not leader

When voters are asked who would make the best PC leader, they are equally likely to mention Christine Elliott (13%) or Doug Ford (12%), rather than other party luminaries such as Caroline Mulroney (10%), Lisa MacLeod (3%), Vic Fedeli (2%) or Rod Phillips and Todd Smith (1% each). Among PC supporters, however, Ford leads (37%), while Elliott is in second (16%), followed by Mulroney (8%). A similar tale is told when we examine past PC voters (2018) where Ford leads (33%) followed by Elliott (16%) and Mulroney 10%).

Voters are asked the same question with Doug Ford taken out of the mix. In this case, Elliott (20%) and Mulroney (15%) are closer, while Lisa MacLeod is in third (5%). Among PC supporters, preference for Elliott is stronger (26%) while Mulroney stays in the same proportion (15%). Among past PC voters, it is a two woman race (Elliott - 27%, Mulroney - 18%). "Ford Nation" is apt to like Todd Smith better than others (10%).

John Tory continues to be seen as best provincial Liberal leader, followed by Crombie, Vaughan

Last tested in May, 2019, provincial Liberal leadership candidates this time included John Tory (again), those who have entered the race officially or were about to (Michel Coteau, Steven Del Duca, Mitzie Hunter, Alvin Tedjo) and newcomers to the list, Bonnie Crombie, Mayor of Mississauga and MP Adam Vaughan. Once again, John Tory dominates this measure with fully one third of the total vote (34%), compared to about a twentieth for each of his nearest rivals, Bonnie Crombie and Adam Vaughan (6% each). Still, these two have twice the

votes of any other stated candidate (Mitzie Hunter, Michel Coteau, Steven Del Duca - 3% each). About one tenth of Ontario voters would like to see someone else, while fully one third have no idea (37%). "Ford Nation" likes Bonnie Crombie better than others do (14%).

Among current provincial Liberal supporters, the preference for Tory is stronger (41%), as is the preference for Vaughan (9%) and Crombie (8%). Following these are Mitzie Hunter and Michel Coteau (5% each) and Steven Del Duca (4%). Among those who actually voted Liberal in June 2018, Tory leads (39%), Vaughan is in second (11%), Crombie third (7%) along with Michel Coteau (7%). They are followed by Steven Del Duca (4%) and Mitzie Hunter (3%).

PCs have highest negatives, Greens and NDP the lowest negatives

As many as 4-in-10 voters will never vote PC (38%), giving them an effective vote ceiling of two thirds (62%). By contrast just one fifth say they will never vote NDP (17%) or Green (18%), giving these parties effective ceilings of over 8-in-10 (83% and 82%, respectively). In total, one quarter will never vote Liberal (23%), giving this party an effective support ceiling of three quarters (77%). Males are more likely to say they will not vote Liberal, NDP or Green than females are, while females are more likely to say they will vote for any party (26%) than are males (17%). Even among "Ford Nation", a tenth will never vote PC (8%).

Conclusion

"Provincially, we are seeing a stubborn equilibrium; neither the recently chastened Liberals nor the governing PCs will relinquish first place to the other, while the official opposition waits just behind in case either stumbles. This is really a rather extraordinary dynamic, considering the Liberal Party is essentially a headless chicken at this point. This should lead us to expect a very competitive race when the chicken finds its head, though, whether it's John Tory or one of the other leading Liberal lights from the GTA. An election featuring Andrea Horwath with her high favourables, the widespread popularity of John Tory, and the baked-in PC support for Christine Elliott would be a very compelling race. Andrea Horwath continues to out poll her party strongly, while Doug Ford underpolls his party considerably. It's as though the PCs are tied in first despite their leader, while the NDP aren't, despite their leader".

"It is disturbing to see that fully six in ten voters think the province is on the wrong track, however. That's an extraordinarily high level of dystopia, and it is safe to say it is related to similarly high levels of disapproval for the job the premier is doing and the relatively high negatives the party carries" said John Corbett, principal and founder of Corbett Communications.

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Methodology

This poll was conducted by Corbett Communications between August 11 and 13, 2019, among an online sample of 1099 Ontario voters 18 years of age and older who are members of Maru/Blue's Maru Voice Canada Online Panel. Panel members are recruited to reflect the population profile described in 2016 Statistics Canada data and are paid various incentives for their participation.

As this is an opt-in sample, no margin of error is presented. For comparison purposes, a probability sample of this size would have a margin of error of plus or minus 3%, nineteen out of twenty times asking.

Where appropriate, data have been weighted to ensure the sample matches the actual population profile according to the latest Statistics Canada data.

This poll is not intended to predict future outcomes but is a "slice of time" view of public opinion. Corbett Communications has released this poll in the public interest and has no stake in its results.
